

New procedures for mobile pantries

In order to effectively meet the growing needs of our community, Manna Cafe will observe new procedures at our mobile pantries.

- You must be present to receive a food box. (You will not be able to pick up for friends and family members.)
- You must provide a photo ID. Only one box per address.
- Registration begins at 8:30 a.m.
- Food distribution begins at 10:00 a.m. and lasts until we run out of food.

Mobile pantries are an extra opportunity to receive food. Manna Cafe's regular food distribution hours are Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 10 a.m. until 4 p.m. at our 605 Providence Blvd. location.
